Artist Bio

Working at the intersections of art, music, engineering and computing, the practice of Huijun Lu culminates in kinetic installations, sculptures, moving images and soundscapes. Consistent in the works are mechanisms and circuits that the artist devises and builds to examine the function and utility of objects, observations about the unnoticed in our environments, as well as technology's role in mediating our relationship with the natural world.

Lu has held solo exhibitions in Singapore, *approximations* (dblspace, 2023) and *loop / pool* (The Esplanade, 2022), and participated in numerous group shows locally and internationally, including in Germany, Portugal, Taiwan, Turkey and the United Kingdom. Most recently, Lu was artist-in-residence at the Taipei Treasure Hill Artist Village from June to August 2025 and has previously completed residencies at Zaratan in Portugal in February 2025 and the Singapore Art Museum from April to September 2024.
